Prior to joining NVG, Erinn served as the Director of Nominations & Cross-Cutting Policies at the National Women’s Law Center, where she led NWLC’s work on judicial integrity, nominations, and democracy. At NWLC, she co-chaired the Leadership Conference on Civil and Human Rights fair courts coalition comprised of civil rights, labor, and progressive organizations, and led the Women’s SCOTUS Table coalition, providing key strategy development and consensus-building to advance priorities.

Prior to her work at NWLC, Erinn served as Senior Policy Counsel for the Lawyers’ Committee for Civil Rights Under Law, where she worked on privacy, tech, education, and judiciary policy, and as a Staff Attorney at the Center for Reproductive Rights. She has also served at the U.S. Department of Justice, where her work focused on consumer protection and appellate civil rights matters. While at DOJ, Erinn was part of a trial team that won a landmark telemarketing civil penalty. She began her legal career as a legal fellow for the National Center for Law and Economic Justice.

Erinn received her J.D. from New York University School of Law, where she was a Frank J. Guarini Leaders in Government Service Scholar and a student advocate in the Brennan Center for Justice Public Policy Advocacy Clinic. She holds a B.A. from the University of Maryland and a M.S. Ed. from the University of Pennsylvania. She was named to the National Bar Association’s Top 40 Under 40 in 2024.
