She focuses primarily on nutrition, healthcare access, vaccines, climate, and immigration.

Carrie started NVG as an intern in the summer of 2023. Before working at NVG, she worked for PennEnvironment, an environmental nonprofit. She advocated for stronger environmental policies from state and local legislators and pushed for more support on environmental bills by connecting with citizens through phone banking, letter writing, and petitions. Carrie also worked for the NYS Comptroller's office in the Department of Investigations, analyzing records to uncover fraud. She also worked as a reporter for the St. Louis American, a St. Louis newspaper dedicated to serving the African American community, covering issues from health crises to income inequality to community bonds.

In 2024, Carrie graduated from Columbia University with a Bachelor of Arts in Political Science and a Bachelor of Arts in Sustainable Development. During her time at Columbia, she was passionate about sustainability and was the president of the Sustainable Development Goal Hub. She organized Columbia Climate Conversations, a speaker panel series that shed light on climate change issues and elevated marginalized voices. She also organized volunteer events with a variety of local organizations near Harlem.
